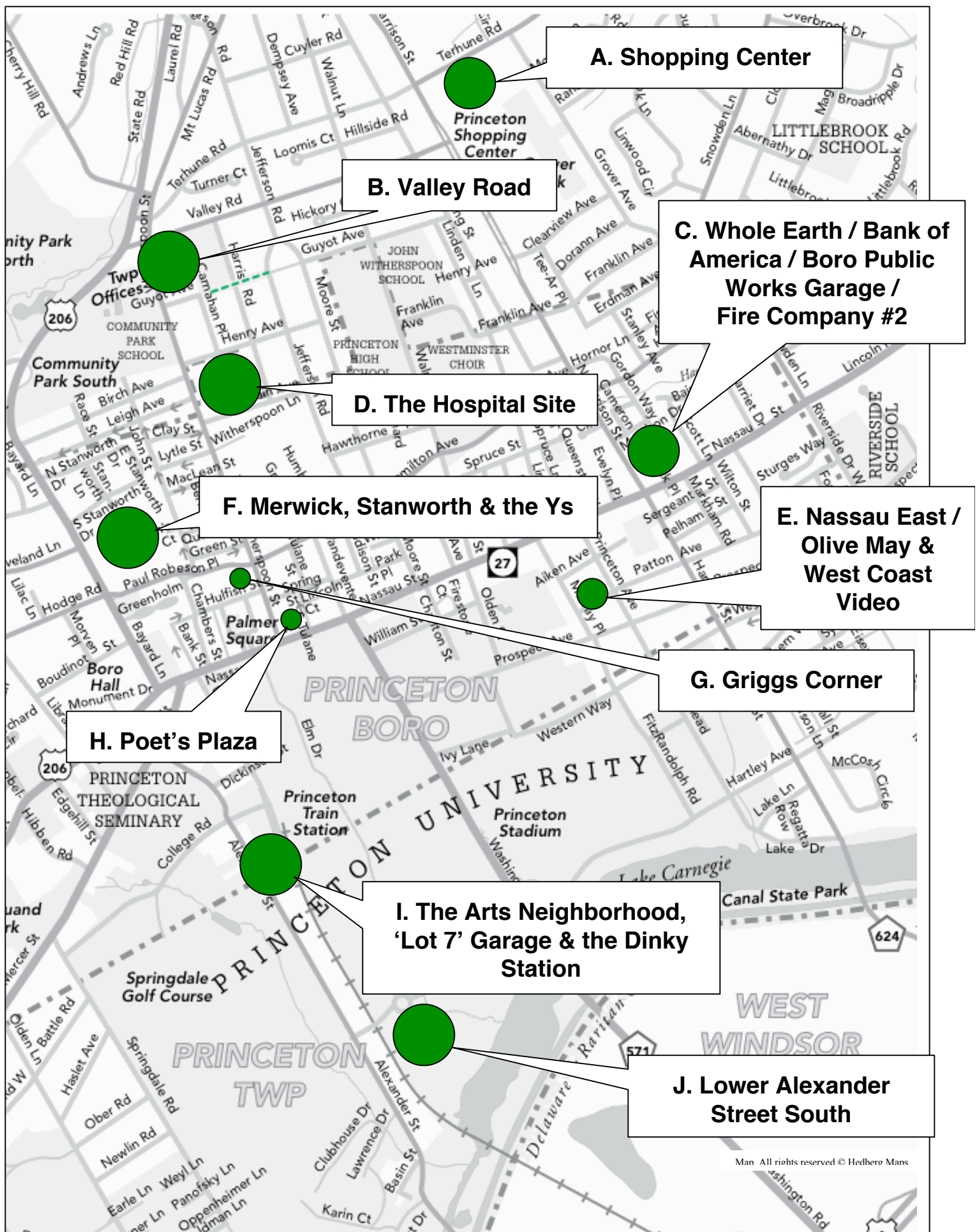
## *Social, Economic & Spatial Questions*
